## Task 4.1 Web-storylines frame

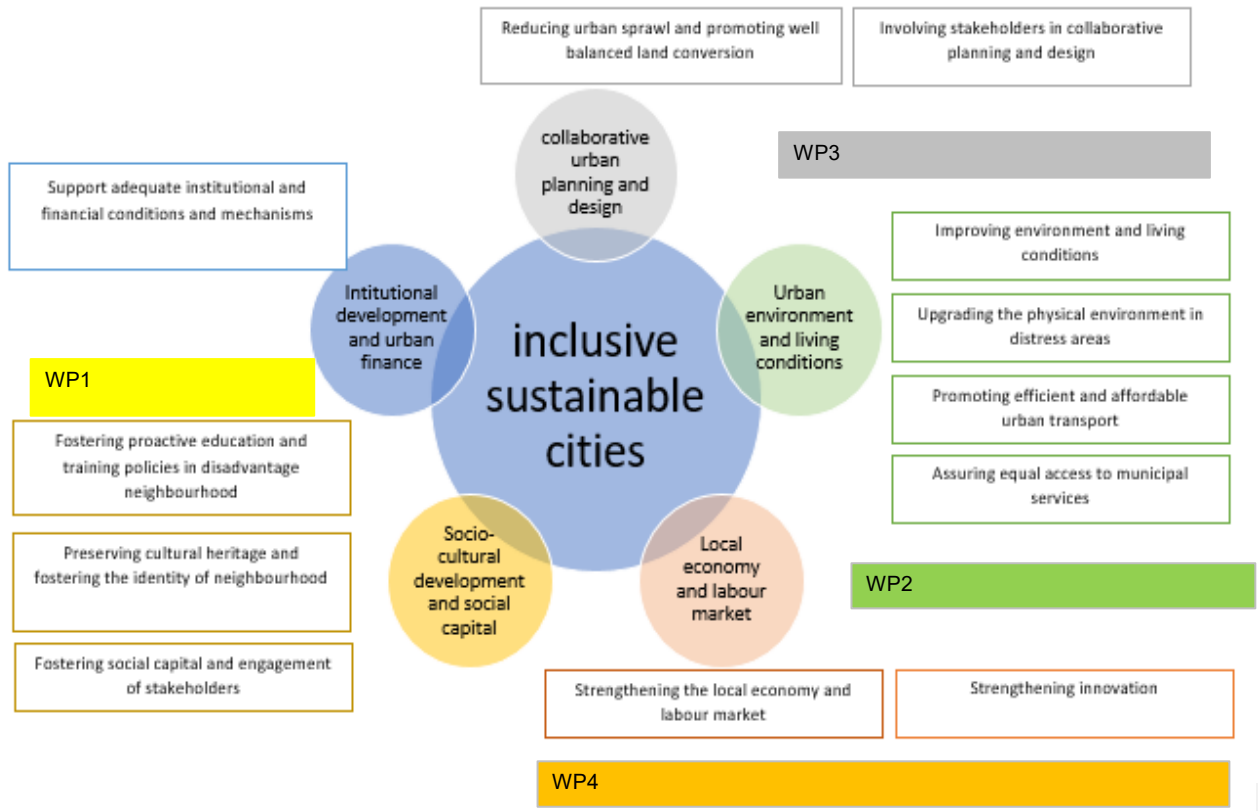
we plan to use storytelling as online and interactive communication tool that can facilitate the cross-reading of the WP1-WP4 results by:

1. **Identify 8-10 key trends that shape the current dominant “regime” in European and Chinese cities ( 2 for each of the 5 aspects of the socially integrative cities identified in D6 .6 ); - July 2020**
2. Collect and illustrate **8-10 inspiring stories of “seeds of changes/Niche”** – innovative, niche practices – able to capture the emergence of new forms of urban governance promoting, inclusive innovation (1/2 for each of the 5 aspects of socially integrative cities); **August- September 2020 to be coordinated with the compendium work**
3. **Categorize the different possible innovations** by type of changes (e.g rapid vs gradual – deliberate vs reactive ) **September – October 2020**
4. Illustrate through an **interactive map the interplay of trends and seeds of changes** on different aspects – as identified by D6.6- socially integrative cities; **September – October 2020**
5. Highlight possible **common “bifurcation points” between EU- China cities** as well as **windows of learning opportunities**; **September – October 2020**
6. Streamline WP1-WP4 main insights and recommendations **September – October 2020**

**First trends ideas** - WP3 could propose trends and review/write the trends table by July related to:

- land expansion
- land renewal
- services offer for migrants

- The trends should use quantitative as well as qualitative and ISINNOVA will also explore possible synergies with SDG targets and indicators;
- The work on stories should be postponed when the W1-WP3 DD are ready so to be sure to make the most of research findings and increase synergies with the compendium structure and results;
- One ideas could be include the 'time' and evolution component of the practices - how did they evolve over time
