State of Work

Financial status: Overview of budget and costs per partner

- 1.8 Mio. Euro of EC funding used from 2.5 Mio. Euro planned budget
- Overall, budget sufficient to complete project (28% of budget remaining for last 6 months).
- Each partner is entitled to receive funding for justified eligible costs up to the amount of the planned budget for that partner (which includes indirect costs/overheads as a flatrate of 25% of direct costs).
- Overall, sufficient budget to finance the book publication, with possible shift of budget between partners (and NTNU using own funding for publication costs).
- **Publication costs of book are eligible costs and each partner should pay and claim the amount for their chapters (~1025 Euro per chapter).**
